# FIRST GREAT MISTAKES !!

II. A second great mistake happened in the 1950's. A young truck driver who played the guitar and sang had a dream. He wanted to be a singer. He auditioned for a record producer who told him to go back to driving trucks. He did not give up on his dream and tried again. This time he was signed and we know him as the King of Rock and Roll. Who was he?

(Write in Elvis)

III. The last great mistake happened in the 1960's in England. Four handsome young men had dream of being the next big musical group. A record producer patiently listened to their sound. He responded by saying that although they were good, that the guitar sound was on its way out. His big mistake was to not signing probably one of the greatest rock bands ever. Who were these young men? (Write in Beatles)

IV. Lastly, does anyone know the first great mistake? (Draw in word first and cross out s in mistakes)

It was the first mistake to happen on planet earth. It happened in a garden. Who committed the first great mistake?

(Put heads on Adam and Eve)

Yes, that's right. God made a beautiful world and gave it over to the first two people who were Adam and Eve.

(Write God in)

What was the first great mistake? They are off the tree of the knowledge of good and evil.

(Put fruit on tree)

God had told them not to eat off this tree or you will surely die and they ate anyway. When you disobey God it is called sin.

(Write in sin)

Adam and Eve committed the first sin and threw the world into turmoil, since that time we have pain, trouble suffering and death in our world. How did this happen? Satan came into the Garden to tempt Adam and Eve. (*Ddraw snake*)

He tempted them in three ways:

### First:**DOUBT**

Did God really say you cannot eat off this tree? How do we doubt God's Word? We doubt by thinking God did not create things but used evolution. Or by saying that Jesus wasn't really God's son, that he was just a man. Or by saying that the Bible is only man's words and that it can not be trusted.

(Draw in 10 commandment tablets)

Lastly, another command says Do not commit adultery. Then Jesus says, "If you look at a woman with lust in your hear then it is adultery." Have you done this? If so, you are an adulterer. 
(Draw arrow for the resurrection)
