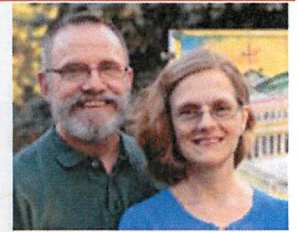

Teaching evangelism: Indian Bible College and more ...

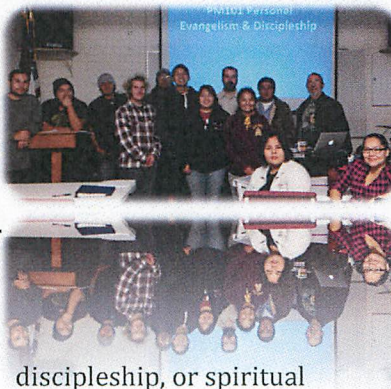

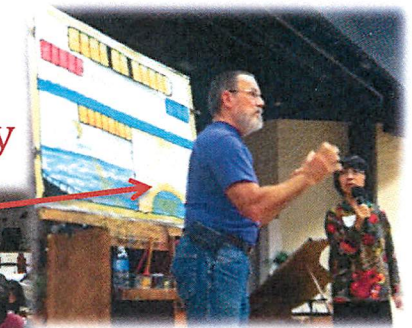

Annual fall outreach to Chinese community of Johns Hopkins University

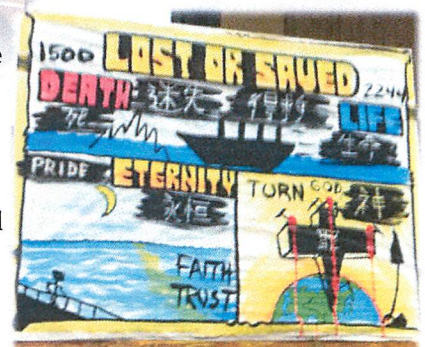


Preaching on stage at the community center of the Church of the Open Door, York, PA.
