

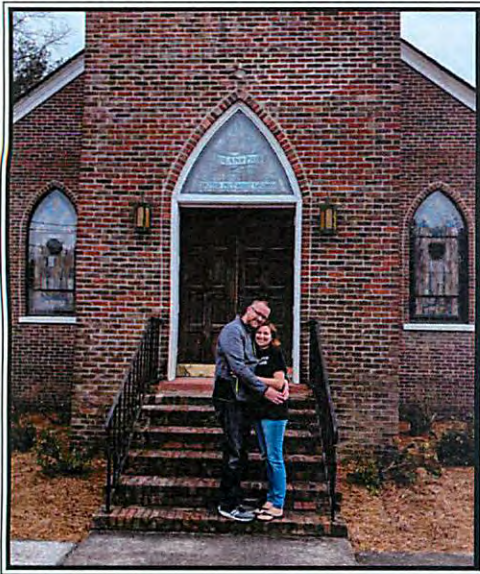

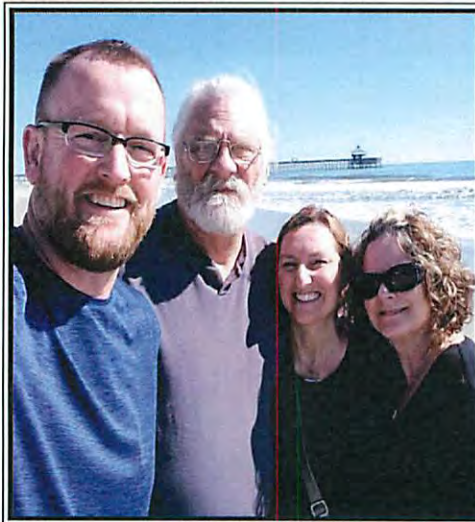

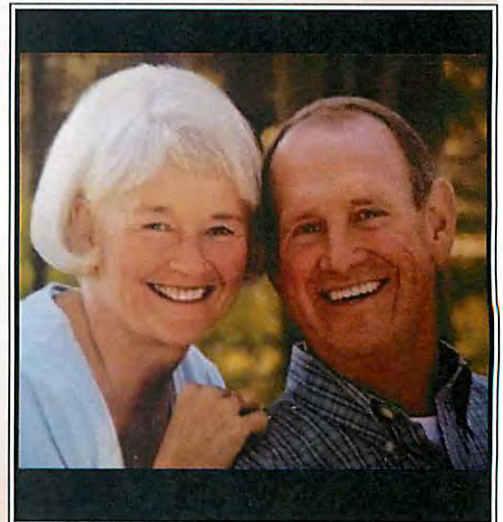


Twenty years ago, Kimberlee and I were walking out the doors of this church in Charleston, SC as newlyweds. We're more in love now than ever 😊

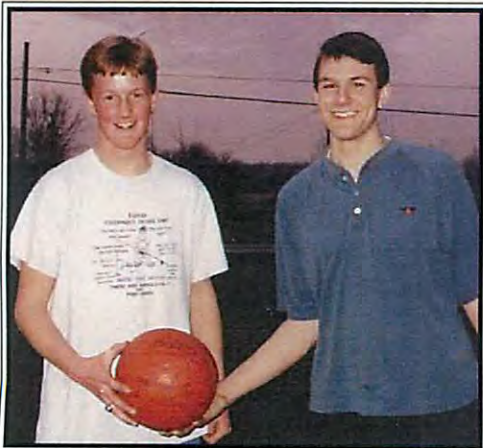

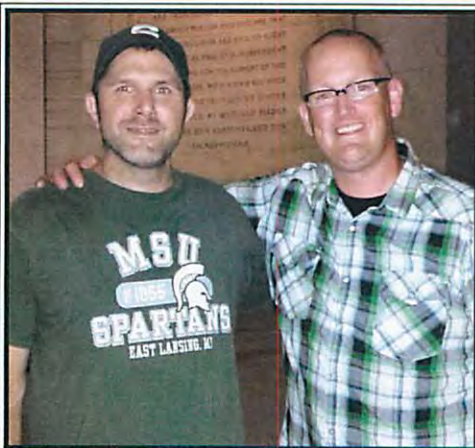

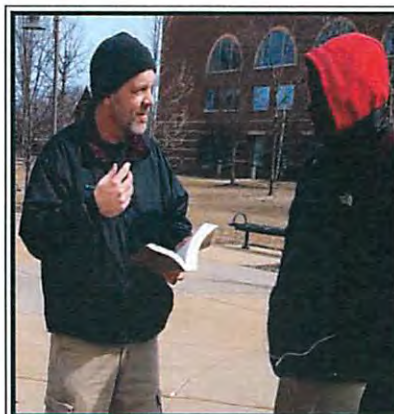
